
This book provides an overview of different environmental problems in South Asia and examines how economic valuation techniques can be used to assess these problems.

Dr. Muhammad Azim Khan, Assistant Professor, Department of Weed Science, AUP got Agricultural Linkage Project from Pakistan Agricultural Research Council on "Predictions of grain yield losses and implication for economic weed managements in Khyber Pakhutnkwha" with total funding of Rs.5.70 million. Dr. Muhammad Saeed, Assistant Professor of the same Department got Higher Education Commission's project on "Integrated management of Trianthema portulacastrum in maize grown for grain and forage purposes in rainfed and irrigated areas of KPK" with a total funding of Rs.1.5 million.

Dr. Ahmad Khan, Assistant Professor, Department of Agronomy, Agricultural University, Peshawar has successfully completed post doctorate from the University of Western Australia as a beneficiary of Endeavour Award of Government of Australia. He worked with the research group of Prof. Mark Tibbett and quantified the interactive effects of soil biota in changing soil ecology with compost addition for enhancing soil biology and nutrients mineralization.



Dr. Khan conducted both glass house as well as incubation experiments and published two papers in Australian Journal of Crop Sciences.

Main focus of the NPRG is to isolate natural products from the potential fungal species for screening against notorious disease causing microbes in plants including wilt pathogens. The NPRG aims to develop novel agro-chemicals from natural sources to combat resistant plant pathogens. The group comprised of 17 members with two faculty and 15 students.





CRANES BREEDING LAUNCHED

Due to its size and beauty, Cranes have long been maintained and propagated in captivity. The Department of Poultry science, Agricultural University, Peshawar has started its breeding in captivity for the first time in Pakistan. The Department is also involved in poultry production on commercial basis.
