The University of Agriculture, Peshawar held its 10th Convocation on January 13, 2016 in a graceful manner. Sardar Mehtab Ahmad Khan Abbasi, Governor / Chancellor, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Universities was the Chief Guest on the occasion.

Medals and degrees were awarded to about 342 students of various disciplines including Agriculture, Biotechnology & Genetic Engineering, DVM, Management



Sciences, Business Administration, CS, IT at Bachelor, Master, M.Phil and PhD level.

In his address, the honourable Chancellor expressed satisfaction over the number of graduating students and hoped that the young generation will fully be prepared to face the future's challenges. He said that development in agriculture is the need of the day as despite availability of sufficient land and resources, the nation is confronted with the challenge of food security. He advised the graduates to work hard with full devotion for the prosperity of the country.

Earlier, in his inaugural speech, the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Zahoor Ahmad Swati lauded the Chancellor for his generous cooperation. He highlighted the achievements of the University and informed that scientists of the University had introduced numerous Wheat varieties including Siran 2010, Atta Habib, Ghaznavi, Janbaz, Ghanimat-e-IBGE and Niamat-e-IBGE. He mentioned that the University has so far produced 13287 Undergraduate, 7563 Postgraduate and 192 PhD graduates since 1981. He said that the University is striving hard to provide all possible facilities and support to its students. The Vice Chancellor appreciated the efforts of organizers of the event.

MoU SIGNED WITH UNIDO



A delegation of UNIDO (United Nations Industrial Development Organization) led by Dr. Ian Goulding

visited the University of Agriculture, Peshawar on December 9, 2014 and held meeting with senior staff of the University chaired by the Acting Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Muhammad Afzal. Purpose of the visit was to address the Food Safety & Quality issues related to trade of food and agro-based industrial products in KP. The interest of the delegation was to launch one year self finance Postgraduate Diploma Course training programme for food professionals in the department of Food Science & Technology. This programme will be carried out under EU TRTA-II (Trade Related Technical Assistance) supported by UNIDO. The MoU was signed by UNIDO representative and the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Zahoor Ahmad Swati.

PEDAGOGICAL TRAINING ORGANIZED

DSP BOARD ESTABLISHED

DSP TEAM VISITED AMSTERDAM



A team of the Dairy Science Park, comprising Prof. Dr. Muhammad Subhan Qureshi, Prof. Dr. Umar Sadique, Prof. Dr. Sarzamin Khan and Mr. Muhammad Imran Khan visited Amsterdam, the Netherlands to attend the 3rd One Health Congress held during March 15-18, 2015.

The tour was sponsored by the United States Department of State's Biosecurity Engagement Programme and Sandia National Laboratories. The One Health concept is based on the recognition that human and animal health is inextricably linked. The scientific programme of the Congress covered all aspects of the One Health concept bringing together established and young scientists working in this rapidly expanding and highly multidisciplinary field. Prevention at the source is key in controlling (infectious) diseases that have a growing impact on humans, animals and their ecosystems. The Congress focused on how science can help in preventing emerging and re-emerging (infectious) diseases.

The sponsors desired to collaborate with the Dairy Science Park in establishing a Center of Excellence on Biorisk Management.

SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO CM VISITED UAP

The University of Agriculture, Peshawar successfully conducted one month training for graduate students on 'Agricultural Production Systems Simulator Modelling(APSIM) during which is computer based software programme, developed by the Agriculture Production System Research (APSR) Unit, Australia. By advancement of IT, APSIM simulates biophysical process of farming systems, in particular where there is interest in economic and ecological outcomes of management practice in face of climatic risk. MoU SIGNED WITH RESCUE-1122



Vice Chancellor, The University of Agriculture, Peshawar, Prof. Dr. Zahoor A. Swati signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Director General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Rescue 1122 on February 09, 2015. In light of MoU, the Rescue 1122 authorities have established an Emergency Response Centre in the premises of the University. The Centre is provided with qualified emergency staff and ambulance for provision of on call and on spot medical emergency services to employees/students/residents of the University. A female medical staff member will also join soon. At first instance, the Centre has started providing rescue and first aid services. The sophisticated ambulance is like a mini mobile hospital and provides most of the medical facilities on spot, beside transporting the patient to nearest hospital.

FACULTY PARTICIPATED IN SYMPOSIUM

A delegation of the University of Agriculture, Peshawar led by Prof. Dr. M. Subhan Qureshi, Dean, Faculty of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Sciences attended the International Symposium on Dairy Animal Reproduction at the University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Lahore during 2015, presented invited paper and co-chaired a technical session.

The Department of Plant Pathology organized "Mushroom Day" during February 22-23, 2016. Students, farmers, Faculty, mushroom growers & lovers, research and extension officers, Field Assistants and other visitors participated demonstrations by the faculty and students of Plant Pathology Department and also enjoyed delicious mushroom soup.

While talking to the visitors, Prof. Dr. Saifullah, Dean

Faculty of Crop Protection Sciences said that no food including fruit and vegetables are safe because of the injudicious application of chemicals. Presently, meat is the major source of protein which is not only expensive but comparatively lower quality and a potential source of many destructive diseases. People in the rural areas are suffering from malnutrition problem. The daily intake of protein in this region of the country is much less, which is increasingly affecting the physical and mental grooming of children and youth as well as contributing in the morbidity and increased number of mortalities in children. Mushroom is a good source of high quality protein, minerals and vitamins, which are essential for human health and also has proven medicinal properties.

During his visit to the Mushroom House, the Vice Chancellor UAP Dr. Zahoor A. Swati appreciated the efforts of Plant Pathology Department, and assured full support to this programme.

FACULTY VISITED MILITARY FARMS OKARA

One day workshop was organized by Prof. Dr. Mohammad Jamal Khan to share the findings of the two studies "Farmers experiences about Climate Change and Farming System" (by Prof. Dr. Mohammad Jamal Khan, Department of Soil Environmental Sciences) and "Climate Scenarios of Bajaur and Mohmand Agency by Dr. Mohammad Hanif, Chief Meteorologist. Technical experts from the University and line departments also participated in the workshop to develop recommendations for aligning the agricultural practices to the foreseen climatic changes.

ACTIVITIES OF CCC



Keeping in view the climate change and its response on crop productivity, the University of Agriculture Peshawar has established a Climate Change Center (CCC) in 2014. The Center conducted a survey in selected districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhuwa, Punjab and FATA to know the growers response on seasonal changes and crops yield. The CCC with financial support of Inter Cooperation is carrying out experiment on rainfed wheat. In the study, 17 high yielding drought resistant varieties were collected from the KP and Punjab. All varieties were planted in four locations (lower Dir, Peshawar, Karak and D.I. Khan) with five sowing dates starting from early November to late December. Main focus of this study is to know the performance of the best varieties in each location and its effect with changing sowing dates by limitation of the rainfall in season.

LIBRARIANS ATTENDED TRAINING

Mr. Rahim Dad, Associate Librarian and Mr. Qamar ud Din, Senior Classifier, Main Library attended 5 day training course on "Role of Information and Communication Technology in Library Management" held during January 26-30, 2015 at Akhtar Hameed Khan National Centre for Rural Development (NCRD), Islamabad.

The main focus was on KOHA (an Open Source Library Software). About 80 Librarians and IT Specialists participated in the training. The resource person



recommended the installation of this software for the automation of academic libraries in Pakistan.



grant courage to the bereaved family to bear this great loss. Ameen
















